RECENT EVENTS

Effective March 31, 2008, James R. Egan has resigned from the position of senior vice president – controller and principal accounting officer, and David B. Kellermann has been appointed to that position. Mr. Egan will remain with Freddie Mac through June 30, 2008 to assist with the transition.

Mr. Kellermann, 40, has been Freddie Mac's Senior Vice President, Business Area Controller, since October 1, 2006. Previously, he was Vice President, Strategy Execution and Integration from February 2005, during which time he also assumed responsibility for the Finance Program Management Office; Vice President, Valuation, Risk Management and Investment Process from November 2003; Vice President, Mortgage Portfolio Investment Process from May 2003; and Portfolio Management Director – Senior from March 2002.
